Be Safe! It's Hurricane Season

Hurricane Safety Tips:

- Remove all outdoor storage and debris from the yard.
- Properly trim all trees and bushes regularly and not wait until a Hurricane watch or warning is issued.
- Construction sites must remove any equipment, garbage debris and supplies from the site when a hurricane watch, or warning is issued.
- Do not place bulk items in the swale during Hurricane watch or warnings.
- Plan Ahead: decide where to move your boat, recreational vehicle, and trailers during a hurricane.
- Check the FEMA and storm preparation websites for hurricane preparation standards.
